Brief overview

Bucks New University is pleased to invite you to join renowned artist Malcolm Plastow, recently awarded a Fellowship of The Royal Society of British Artists, for a five day intensive Figure & Landscape Life Drawing short course.

This course will support your exploration of direct observational drawing and painting and use a wide range of techniques and artistic viewpoints to enhance your figure and landscape life drawing techniques.

The course will be run in the splendour of a former medieval abbey set in the heart of the Chilterns, surrounded by ten acres of spectacular grounds. The course will begin with life work in the studio and then, weather permitting, we will move outdoors into the stunning landscape setting around the Missenden Abbey.

As part of this course we will look at ways of placing the figure in a natural landscape setting; we will also explore the possibilities of an accompanying narrative. In addition we will consider historically relevant examples of art as well as contemporary examples in order to further extend the possibilities for creative exploration.

Key features

Group critiques and presentations, including peer and tutor oral exchanges are all part of your natural artistic development and at the end of your course you will have learned how to:

- Observe and make visual representations based on the figure and landscape
- Come to terms with visual problems encountered
- Choose and make creative use of a range of tools and media in relation to the subject matter
- Show a range of work produced during the period of the course.

This will involve continuous formative assessment as the course progresses and, at the end of the course, you will receive confirmation of attendance from Bucks New University.

The course is run by Bucks New University and is equivalent to 20 credits of a first year undergraduate bachelor degree.
